ON JANUARY 11, 2003 nearly 400 people opposed to a second Gulf War gathered on the stairs of the Traverse City Governmental Center for a Community Peace Portrait. Citizens of all ages from at least five area counties and from all walks of life raised their signs and hands in support of peace and opposition to war. Today, January 18, 2003, nearly 175 area residents join a predicted half-million person anti-war march in front of the Capitol in Washington DC.
